ORGANIZATION HISTORY & STRUCTURE

The Luverne Commercial Club was organized to promote and support Luverne businesses in 1918. In 1941, the organization was renamed Luverne Civic and Commerce Association and applied for non-profit 501 C6 status under Minnesota Statutes. *Today, our official name is the Luverne Area Chamber and Convention & Visitors Bureau.* Luverne Area Chamber continues to operate under the objectives that were envisioned almost 100 years ago:

"To develop, encourage, promote, and protect the commercial, professional, financial, general business and residential interests of the City and surrounding area of Luverne; to promote the civic interests and the general welfare of the community; to extend and promote trade and commerce, and foster, develop and protect the industry and residential developments of the Luverne area."

Membership is comprised of any person, firm, association or corporation interested in the general welfare of the City of Luverne and the surrounding area.

The organization is directed by a Board of Directors who are responsible for conducting the business of the Chamber. The Board of Directors consists of twelve members elected at the Annual Meeting. Four directors shall be elected each year. In the case of a resignation, the Chamber Board may appoint a person to fill the seat. The membership shall elect a Board *President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary* at the Annual Meeting to conduct the business of the Board. The Annual Meeting is held in the month of December.

The Board appoints an Executive Director and Administrative Assistant who shall direct the day to day operation of the Chamber including the management of property, business and affairs of the corporation and shall perform such functions and duties as may be delegated by the Board of Directors and/or the President.

LUVERNE AREA CHAMBER - 2023

Luverne's Chamber is in a unique position to facilitate and support tourism in Rock County. Through a partnership with Rock County, the Herreid Military Museum and the Brandenburg Gallery—Chamber staff manages the building that houses two local visitor attractions. From January 1, 2023 through November 30, 2023—the Rock County Veterans Memorial Building welcomed 4,847 visitors. The building is open M-F from 8 am to 5 pm and Saturdays from 10 am to 5 pm.

2023 was a busy year for the Chamber:

- We coordinated day visits from 5 bus groups and assisted in planning for 3 family reunions and 4 high school reunions.
- We assisted in coordinating the first induction event for the Luverne Public Schools Hall of Fame.
- With the three leased 6-passenger golf carts and the creation of a variety of tours—we provided tours for approximately 681 people throughout the spring, summer and early fall.
- We coordinated and hosted four events for community children including a special Easter event, Touch a Truck Night, Summer Fun on the Plaza and Halloween Trunk N Treat.
- Chamber staff also worked with the Destination Branding Committee to install three additional fine art 7 foot nutcrackers on the Main Street corridor and celebrate their installation in September.
- Partnering with businesses and organizations in our community—we coordinated or assisted with many successful events: Spring City-wide Rummage Sales, Love the Burger Battle, Farmers Market, Buffalo Days, Hot Dog Nite, Tractor Ride, 11 mini-events at the Plaza on Main, Chamber Golf Outing, We Love Pork Battle, Tri-State Band Festival, LIFT Annual Social, Veterans Day, Santa Train & Light the Night and Winterfest. On average, estimated attendance and participation for the events increased.
- The Chamber coordinated the Veterans Banner Program on Main Street in partnership with the City of Luverne and the LIFT Design Committee.
- The Chamber offered assistance with various community organizations to coordinate registrations, sales and special projects to support non-profits.
- On average, Chamber staff responds to approximately 8-10 calls per day from individuals, businesses and organizations asking for information.
- Chamber Board hosted 7 ribbon-cuttings for new businesses and facilities over the year.
- We distributed 78 Welcome to Luverne Bags to new residents.

CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU

The Chamber is honored to staff the LUVERNE CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU. The Luverne CVB was formed by the City of Luverne to utilize locally controlled hotel lodging tax to promote and support visitor traffic.

The CVB is administered by an independent Committee that is comprised of members representing lodging, restaurants, retail, general business and organizations with a representative from the City of Luverne and the Luverne Area Chamber Board of Directors. This Committee makes decisions on promotional investments.

Programs they offer to increase visitor traffic include:

- Operating the Chamber as an official Explore Minnesota Affiliate Travel Information Center to serve visitors with information for local and state travel opportunities
- Digital presence on the Explore Minnesota website
- Print advertising in State, regional and national travel magazines
- Promotional advertising in the Twin Cities metro area
- Interstate billboard and Minnesota Logos advertising
- Operation of the ROLL ON LUVERNE PROGRAM (borrow a bike)
- Distribution of 35 cases Luverne Visitors Guides to Minnesota Travel Information Centers, Chambers & CVB's throughout Minnesota
- Assisted in planning and coordinating special group tours, class reunions and family events to Luverne and Rock County
- Respond to individual requests for local information to visitors and new residents from leads generated by print advertising we have fulfilled over 950+ individual requests for the Luverne Visitor Guide
- The CVB coordinates one community event that bring people to town; the Get Hooked Ice Fishing Derby
- Plans, coordinates and executes events, programs and services that market the Northern Tallgrass Prairie in Rock County
- The Chamber operates the Welcome to Luverne digital billboard that promotes community and special events
- The CVB partnered with the Luverne EDA and coordinated four days of shooting for promotional videos and photographs
- A new 30 second bike trail ad was developed in collaboration with Media One.

Witness the impressive collection at the History Center, catch a wave of nostalgia at the Verne Drive In and Palace Theatre or marvel at the works of nature photographer and Luverne native Jim Brandenburg at the Brandenburg Gallery.

TAKE 16 BREWERY

This well-known, local brewery offers the best in craft beer.

TRAIL SYSTEM

Explore the 15+ miles of trail that weave through Luverne and connect the city to the prairie. Whether an impromptu evening walk or a lengthy afternoon bike ride, the trails are an easy way to get your body moving and get outdoors! Rent an E-bike, borrow-a-bike and enjoy your own two wheels...you'll enjoy the ride!

BLUE MOUNDS STATE PARK

This state park is full of surprises! Named for the 1.5 mile Sioux Quartzite cliff line that appeared blue to early settlers, Blue Mounds State Park allows for the unique experience of seeing bison in their native habitat. See the stunning prairie grasses and wildflowers, hear the songs of a variety of native birds, and experience camping, hiking, and rock-climbing on Minnesota's native prairie playground.

TOUCH THE SKY PRAIRIE

Hike the 1,000 acres of the Northern Tallgrass Prairie Refuge at the Brandenburg Prairie Foundation's Touch the Sky Prairie. This beautifully preserved stretch of land is open to the public for activities such as hiking, bird watching, hunting and photography. Managed by the US Fish and Wildlife Service, you'll see hundreds of native plants brought back from near extinction as North America's native prairie has dwindled from more than 170 million acres to a mere 1% remaining. Touch the Sky Prairie is a "must-see" for all nature lovers.

HISTORY CENTER

Immerse yourself in the area's history by visiting the History Center. Uncover secrets in Rock County's past thru original furnishings, interactive displays, photographs and research materials covering over 150+ years - including a claim shanty, covered wagon and Luverne Auto built in 1911. Sidestep into the nutcracker gallery to learn why Luverne now has more nutcrackers than people and how the collection of 5,500+ (one of the largest in the world) came to be.

HERREID MILITARY MUSEUM

Dive into the rich history of Rock County veterans at the Herreid Military Museum located in the beautifully restored Rock County Jail & Sheriffs House. The museum shares the stories of Rock County's men and women who answered the call to serve told through their artifacts, photographs and documents covering the Civil War to the present. An extensive collection of WWII memorabilia shares the stories of Rock County heroes like Quentin Aanenson, who served as a P-47 pilot in the ETO and was featured in Ken Burns' 2007 epic documentary, *THE WAR*.

The Luverne Area Chamber and CVB are honored to staff the community treasure, the ROCK COUNTY VETERANS MEMORIAL BUILDING. Opening July 18, 2009, the building is home to the Brandenburg Gallery, Herreid Military Museum and offices of the Chamber.

The Gallery is operated by the Brandenburg Prairie Foundation and features two floors of photographs by award winning, former National Geographic nature photographer and Luverne native Jim Brandenburg. Proceeds from Gallery sales and fundraising are dedicated to saving the fragile Northern Tallgrass Prairie Refuge—Touch the Sky Prairie.

The upper two floors of the building house the Herreid Military Museum. The museum features the story of men and women from Rock County who served this great country from the Civil War through today. The museum is the vision of philanthropists Warren G. Herreid and Jeannine M. Rivet who remodeled the former Rock County Sheriff's Office, Home and Jail into this state-of-the-art museum.

The building is open 52 hours per week free of charge for residents and visitors to enjoy. Approximately 6,000 people visit the building for tours and special events each year.
